Items to be checked or circled may be in ink, not pencil. ***Incomplete applications will not be considered.***

Applications ***WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED*** without each of these items:

- All pages of this application, with complete information. Be sure to sign and date the application on the last page.
- Original transcript or certified school copy of your most recent completed academic year (high school or college.) If you are in your first year of college, please **ALSO** include a transcript of your first semester's grades.
- A copy of your current Tripoli membership card or a copy of the current Tripoli membership card of your relative. If you cannot provide this proof of eligibility, include a separate written statement explaining why you cannot do this.
